- 1. Homework both study and written is assigned Monday through Thursday evening. It is the student's responsibility to make sure all assigned homework is copied in the homework journal before leaving the classroom. After 5 missed homeworks students will receive an after school detention.
- 2. Arrival time for students is now 7:40. Please do not drop off your child before 7:40. Breakfast is from 7:40-7:50. All students not eating breakfast will report to the gym.
- 3. If your child is being signed out early from school, a written note must be sent in stating the reason. A parent/guardian MUST come in to the building and sign that child out. Please bring Photo ID. If someone else is signing your child out of school, he/she must be listed on the student's emergency contact form. No child may be signed out after 2pm.
- 4. The student must make up all class work and homework missed due to being absent. It will be their responsibility to find out what assignments were missed and make them up in a timely manner. Please remember, as the number of absences increase, your child's grades may decrease. Please check the student handbook for new lateness and absence policies.
- 5. Tests and Quizzes, regardless of the grades, must be signed and returned to school to be kept on file. For grading information please check MSP, It is very important that you are checking this regularly. If you need your login please contact Mr. Jackson.
