We are trying to encourage time management and responsibility. We encourage you work with your family on projects but remember this is YOUR project. In trying to develop 21<sup>st</sup> Century skills, we recommend that work be typed. Work can be saved on a flash drive and printed out in school.

#### Revisions:

If you are unhappy with a grade you have received please see me and we can discuss a revision. All revisions must be completed before the next chapter has begun.

#### Extra Credit:

I will be offering extra credit throughout the year. Extra credit is a privilege in my classroom and students will be notified when it is available. Extra credit is only available to those who have completed all previous assignments.

### <u>Academic Honesty:</u>

Students are expected to complete their own assignments. Plagiarism is not tolerated. If it occurs the student can be given a zero on the assignment based on the severity of the plagiarism. If it happens a second time student will be referred to the office for additional discipline.

## **General Procedure & Expectations:**
